PLANS FOR THE MULTIPURPOSE BUILDING STAY ON TRACK

The Trustees, in spite of the down turn of the economy, are moving forward with plans for the proposed 80' x 100' multipurpose facility. It will be located on the west side of the main driveway. The

sand volleyball court and basketball court will be moved to another location to accommodate the site for the new building.

The facility will provide seating for 300 persons, accommodate basketball, volleyball and other indoor sports, and will provide spaces for classes, rainy day activities, etc.

A concept drawing has been approved by the camp trustees. A copy of the concept drawing and a rendering of the building are shown on page 3.

If funds become available, the Trustees will authorize the construction of the "shell" of the building at the end of the 2009 camp season. The interior of the building would then be completed as funds become available.

If funds are not forthcoming in 2009, this project would have to be delayed until 2010 or thereafter. Hopefully, many individuals will want to invest in this effort.
